## P06 -SPRAY CONVERSIONS / EXISTING SYSTEM UPGRADES

This policy has been created to ensure that the correct application procedures are followed when a shareholder(s) wish to convert an existing border-dyke property to spray irrigation or upgrading an existing spray irrigation system including new irrigation.

It is important that LWIC obtain this information from shareholders prior to the commencement so assessments can be made on the ability to supply water at the requested point of take, the effects on scheme operation, environmental impact and any other issues that may arise.

- Shareholders must contact and discuss any proposed new irrigation system with the Race Manager prior to system design.
- Application forms must be completed and submitted for approval by the Board of Directors.
- Incomplete applications will not be accepted.
- All new irrigation systems must be designed and installed according to the "Irrigation Code of Practice and Design Standards".
- A design approval certificate must be obtained before any construction starts.
- The Company must be informed once construction is completed, and an assessment will be done to ensure all LWIC requirements have been met.
- The conversion (or upgrade) will be signed off in the form a letter of acceptance from the Company once an assessment has been carried out to ensure that all requirements have been met.
